### Objectives

To develop 'Gold Standards' for PRM control, also confirming the full potential of PRM to poultry and other sectors

### Specific objectives

- Produce guidelines for prevention (leaflets), surveillance and control (chemical/nonchemical) of PRMs produced within the framework of existing 'Hazard Analysis and Critical Control Points' procedures
- Review the economic and social impact of PRMs, and foster further study on PRM in non-avian hosts with medical and veterinary practitioners

## Cross-link questions

- What are the impacts of PRMs on the poultry industry and beyond? (WG1, WG2)
- How can the targeted stakeholders use the findings? (WG1-4)

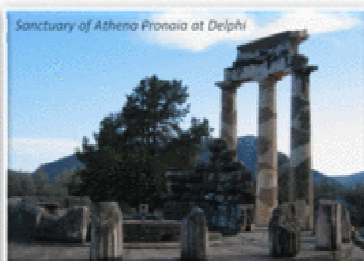

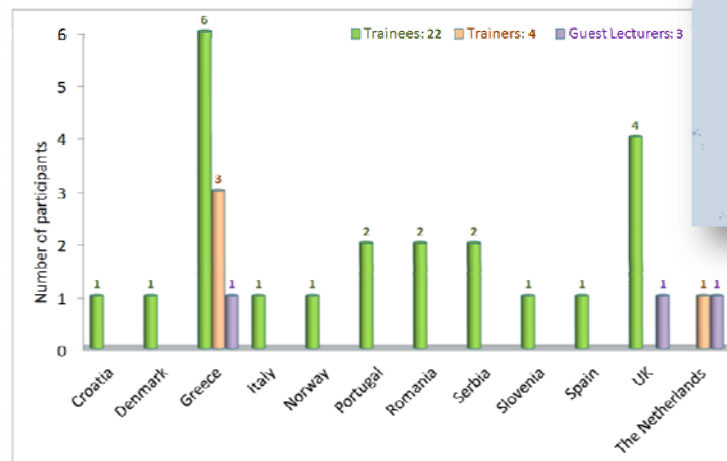

## Training School

To bring the study of *D. gallinae*  
to a multidisciplinary audience  
under the One Health approach

**29 participants** from **12 countries**  
incl. 8 trainees from 5 ITCs (27.6%)  
mean age 34.3 years; : 55% : 44%





Intrinsic weakness: PRM is a cosmopolitan hematophagous ectoparasite of wild, domestic and synanthropic birds presenting serious economic threats to the laying hen sector.

*The contribution of PRM to the 'one health' approach remains ill-defined*

### Fields of interest – High quality products

- ✓ Need for preliminary controlled human studies to identify e.g. immunological markers associated with PRM infestation – **Consider grant applications**
- ✓ Expansion of the **COREMI website and social media activities**
- ✓ Establishment of **online case report platform** with app support
- ✓ Production of **leaflets** with increasing levels of detail from poultry farmers to veterinarians and clinicians (*UNDER PREPARATION*)
- ✓ Preparation of a **position paper** emphasising all relevant 'one health' points (*UNDER SUBMISSION*)
