professionals

DATES/VENUE: 31 July 2017 – 3 August 2017; Nafsika Palace, Itea, Greece

APPLICATION DEADLINE: 30 March 2017

FUNDING: Successful applicants will receive individual stipends from COST FA1404;

including a reasonable amount for travel expenses (using the most

economical means of travel available) and a fixed amount for housing and social activities at the venue, TS material and transfer from/to Athens Airport (flights should be planned to arrive by noon on 31.7.2017 & depart after early afternoon on 4.8.2017). Additional successful applicants may attend provided that expenses are funded by sources other than COST.

GOALS & LAYOUT

The Training School intends to bring the study of D. gallinae to a multidisciplinary audience under the One Health approach. The course aims to (a) widen the cross-sectoral knowledge on the pathological manifestations in humans associated with exposure to poultry red mite (PRM) and its control measures; (b) provide training on reliable and effective strategies that need to be applied to increase the awareness of professionals on PRM; (c) encourage interaction among medical doctors, veterinarians, academic and industrial researchers, public and occupational health officers; (d) disseminate the outcome to improve well-being through risk prevention and management. The trainees¹ will work in groups in order to develop flexible knowledge and effective problem solving skills through collaboration and intrinsic motivation. Certificates will be issued upon successful completion of the course.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The application should include: (1) <u>Letter of motivation (max 1 page)</u> stating expertise, work experience and accomplishments, as well as why the applicant wishes to participate in the training school and to be considered for a COST grant. The exact requirements for travel expenses need to be specified. (2) <u>CV in tabular form (max 1 page)</u> including personal information, contact details (affiliation, address, e-mail, phone number) and information on education, occupation and scientific activities. (3) <u>List of publications (max 1 page)</u> including full citation of articles already published or accepted for publication. If necessary, abbreviate the list to recent publications. (4) <u>Support letter (max 1 page)</u> stating why the supervisor/PI feels that the applicant should participate and whether travel costs exceeding 300.00€ can be covered.

These 4 parts should be prepared in a single **.pdf** document with page breaks (font Times New Roman 11pt, line spacing 1.5, margins 2cm on all sides), named "TrainingSchool2017_APPLICANT'S NAME" and attached to a brief e-mail with a subject line: "TrainingSchool2017 Application APPLICANT'S NAME" addressed to <u>aityliga@med.uoa.gr</u> & c/c to <u>andrikava@hotmail.com</u>.
